

Charlottesville Waldorf School Grade School Aftercare Program

Program Description:

The Grade School aftercare program provides a supervised after school environment. The afternoon follows a daily rhythm that includes a time for snack, for homework or quiet activity, and a time for more active play. Seasonal activities are also a regular part of the aftercare program, such as baking and garden work.

Grade School Aftercare Teacher:

We are delighted to have Paige Hartsell as our grade school aftercare teacher. This will be her third year serving in this position. She brings a wealth of experience and tremendous care to the job.

What to bring:

- A hearty snack and a water bottle
- Sufficient layers and rain gear- the children will go out and play in all weather. Please remember that it can cool off significantly in the late afternoon.

Aftercare Fees:

Contracted Rate 3:00-4:00pm, \$10/day 3:00-5:30pm, \$15/day

Drop-in Rate 3:00-4:00pm, \$15/day 3:00-5:30pm, \$20/day

Note* * For both contracted and drop-in, the cost of the first child is full price, cost for a sibling is 50% off and any additional siblings are free.

Late Fee: There is a \$25 charge for children picked up after 5:30 pm. It is as distressing for us to have to charge this fee as it is, surely, for you to receive it. As always, our primary concern is for the welfare of the children; it can be very upsetting for a child to wait to be picked up late. It is also stressful for the aftercare staff who may have second jobs or classes. However, if you experience a genuine emergency, please let us know so we can accommodate you appropriately.
